1. SELECTION CRITERIA

Include, but are not limited to:

- commitment to the mission of Catholic education of boys in the Jesuit tradition;
- An understanding of the educational needs of boys and young men;
- appropriate teaching qualifications and eligibility to teach under the requirements of NSW Educational Standards Authority (NESA), NSW legislation and College policy;
- ability to design, implement and evaluate curriculum collaboratively in accordance with College and NESA syllabus guidelines;
- demonstrated collegial leadership (*this may be demonstrated in a variety of capacities across a school*);
- demonstrated experience in working collaboratively with colleagues to develop and implement a sequential and integrated Sport Program in a Primary School;
- possess a working knowledge of the NSW primary school PDHPE curriculum and its implementation;
- proven ability to ensure teaching and learning activities reflect contemporary pedagogy, including the ability to integrate an inquiry-based approach to teaching and learning and differentiation strategies;
- understanding of, and ability to use data to analyse, report on and manage student progress, and to report to parents in a variety of ways that keep them regularly and fully informed of their child's progress;
- ability to create a positive, supportive and engaging classroom climate that meets the academic, social and emotional needs of all students;
- ability and willingness to evaluate and critically reflect upon own professional practice, and continue professional learning, including contributing to the broader school community;
- significant competency in the use of ICT, and its integration into the curriculum;
- ability to work cooperatively within a team context;
- (high level of) organisation and time management;
- effective and efficient conflict resolution skills;
- excellent interpersonal skills and the ability to respond appropriately to diverse stakeholders;
- commitment to participate in the College's pastoral and co-curricular programs.
