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### 1. SELECTION CRITERIA

Include, but are not limited to:

- commitment to the mission of Catholic education of boys in the Jesuit tradition;
- an understanding of the educational needs of boys and young men;
- appropriate Primary teaching qualifications, specifically Visual Arts, and eligibility to teach under the requirements of NSW legislation and College policy;
- experience in teaching Primary (Years 3-6) Visual Arts;
- ability to design, implement and evaluate curriculum collaboratively in accordance with College and NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) syllabus guidelines;
- proven ability to ensure teaching and learning activities reflect contemporary pedagogy, including the ability to integrate an inquiry based approach to teaching and learning;
- ability to organise art room and art materials, and order art materials as needed;
- creative approach to the display of student work in appropriate display areas, and organisation of Annual Art exhibitions;
- capacity to create and maintain Junior School allocated annual Art Budget;
- understanding of, and ability to use data to analyse, report on and manage student progress, and to report to parents in a variety of ways that keep them regularly and fully informed of their children's progress;
- ability to create a positive, supportive and engaging classroom climate that meets the academic, social and emotional needs of all students;
- ability and willingness to evaluate and critically reflect upon own professional practice, and continue professional learning, including contributing to the broader school community;
- significant competency in the use of ICT, and its integration into the curriculum;
- High level of organization and time management;
- effective and efficient conflict resolution skills;
- succinct, effective communication (oral and written) skills;
- commitment to participation in the pastoral and co-curricular programs of the College.
